Yrs of 6<sup>th</sup> - just rec'd -  
I must have Alexis with me again if possible -  
Circumstances prevent my coming for him -  
The advanced season allows not timely remittance  
for him to start and get here seasonably - hence  
this dispatch, and the necessity of asking your  
special aid & assistance in the case -

Can you - will you, thru advance, for me,  
the needful, and start Alexis & family off at once,  
with means and arrangements to reach here with  
convenience and safety, this fall? - Put him into  
the regular transportation line - furnish with  
"through tickets," and what for contingencies  
you may deem necessary and proper, & advise me therof.

On receipt of your Telegraphic acknowledgement  
of this, and ready compliance with its  
suggestions, I will immediately forward to you  
per Mail, an Exchange Draft on New York, for  
\$100) One hundred dollars, to be applied at discretion for  
purposes intended - Respectfully yours.
