Dear Sir

I have delayed replying to your letter of June 30 because I have been trying ever this to go into the laboratory to attempt something with the Gastric Fluid. I can only say that hitherto I have found it impossible owing to unceasing & varied demands on my time. I write now merely that

you may know that I have not forgotten you. I do not feel at present any thing to hinder my doing something for you within a few days & if you are about to remove from Matlinsburg you please to give me notice & in the mean time remember what I said to you last Friday, that I have no great confidence in myself on this subject. The moment I hear from Dr. Dopp

Bergthius I will write to you but I think we cannot expect to hear from him within several months. —
