of Drs Archer, Weightman, Lea, Mendenhall,
Mower, Hale, Stevenson, Beaumont, Kearney,
Patches, Day, Catlett are settled to the 30th of Sept
1822, & those of Dr Longdon at Fort Wood, Everett
at Fort Columbus, McMahon at Germantown,
Livingston finally closed.
