II. . . By direction of the Secretary of War, a  
Medical Board, to be composed of

Surgeon W. Beaumont,

Surgeon P. H. Craig,

Surgeon R. C. Wood,

and Surgeon H. A. Stinnie, Supernumerary  
member, will convene at Fort Brooke, Florida,  
on the 15<sup>th</sup> of November, 1839, or as soon thereafter  
as practicable, for the purpose of examining  
such Surgeons, and Assistant Surgeons of the  
Army, as may be ordered to present themselves  
before it.

Should any of the above named members  
be absent at the time specified, the senior  
member present will organize the Board by  
taking up the Supernumerary, and proceed to  
business.

III. . . After the adjournment of the Board,  
the several officers composing it will report to  
the Commanding General in Florida for duty.
