A warrant, No. 138 having been issued yesterday in your favor, for three dollars and twenty five cents due to the estate of Richard Flemming,

In favor of the Receiver of Public Moneys at Detroit, for \$ 3. 25

who is instructed to purchase your bills so drawn.
