Summer Normal 1929
Four weekcourse

My dear -----:

I have your letter of _____, in which you ask for information concerning the Summer Normal Class, which will be conducted by Central Institute for the Deaf.

The course will be of four weeks' duration, from June 24 to July 24, and will be held in the new auditorium of the Central Institute for the Deaf. Only experienced teachers of the deaf are eligible for this course.

The subjects to be included are: Voice Building; Speech Development; Conservation of Residual Hearing; Graded Work in Language; Anatomy and Physiology of the Organs or Speech and Hearing; The Acoustic Method; Functional Tests of Hearing. A course in Treatment of Behavior Problem Children in School will be given by Miss Gath of Washington University, for which two university credits will be given. Prof. Meyer will lecture on Saturdays, his subject to be announced later. Lectures will be given by the faculty of Central Institute, for which credits will be given.

The price for the course is \$100.00 and includes tuition fee, board, lodging, two persons in a room. An additional fee of \$10.00 will be charged for single rooms. Tuition fee for the course alone is \$55.00. A certificate will be issued to each teacher who satisfactorily completes the course.

Gebhart will lecture daily on Theory and Practice of Lipreading, Miss Gath of Washington University will lecture on Treatment of Behavior Problem Children in School, for which 2 university credits will be given, and Prof. Meyer will lecture on Saturdays, his subject to be announced later.

The price for the course will be \$125.00 and will include tuition fee, room and board, two persons in a room. An additional fee of \$10.00 will be charged for single rooms.
