The services of Surgeon Beamont being no longer necessary here, he has permission to avail himself of the furlough which has been granted him for six months by the proper authority.

Dr. Beamont will accompany & attend the wounded Militia as far as St. Louis, who were left here in hospital, & who are going down in the Steam Boat William Wallace to that place.
