Paris 16. March 1854

"my dear Sir

I am very much obliged to you for Dr. Beaumont's book of experiments, of which I <sup>have</sup> kept <sup>one</sup> a copy and give the others to Dr. Dupela, the Director of the faculty of medicine, to the academy of sciences of the Institute & to the academy of that body, of which I am a member. In the academy of sciences it has been referred to a committee to determine whether any additional experiments to those reported by Dr. Beaumont, are necessary for the interest of medical science, and if so, whether it will be expedient to send for them now here, or to request that the experiments be made in the United States. As soon as the report is made I will send it to you."
