Dear Beaumont

I rec^d your favor of 15th Inst enclosing
\$14 Dollars the amt. of my Disbursements in finding clothes
S^r Martin. - There will be no difficulty in getting him
Back at any reasonable price providing you
will employ his Wife!!! also - he is miserably
Poor and will remain so while he lives unless
he comes back to you. I think you had
better write to me in New York requesting me
to engage Alexis & his Wife to come up and remain
with you one or two years - I will bring them
up to Mackinac in the Company's Boats and charge
as low as possible - Doctor Catwell saw him
when he was in Montreal, lost and wished very
much to get him to remain with him
